## INTRODUCTION

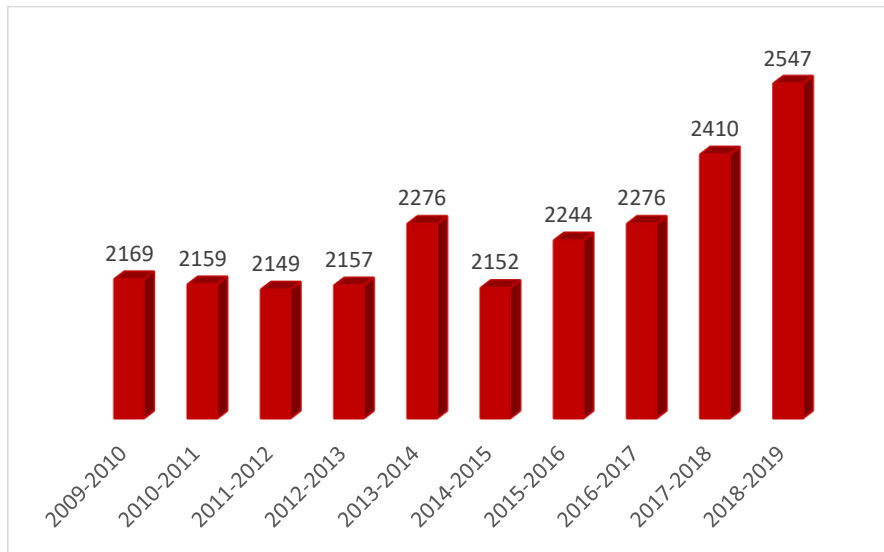

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## I. Participation by UW-Madison Degree Seeking Students\* Studying Abroad by Academic Year: 10-year summary

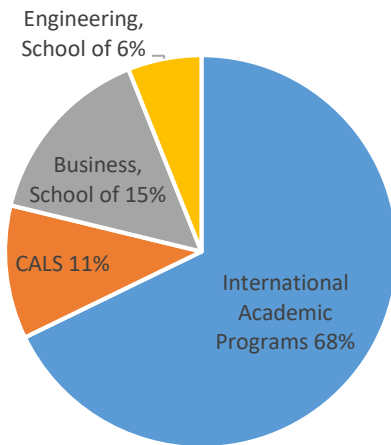

## II. Participation by UW-Madison Students who Studied through a Study Abroad Administrative Unit

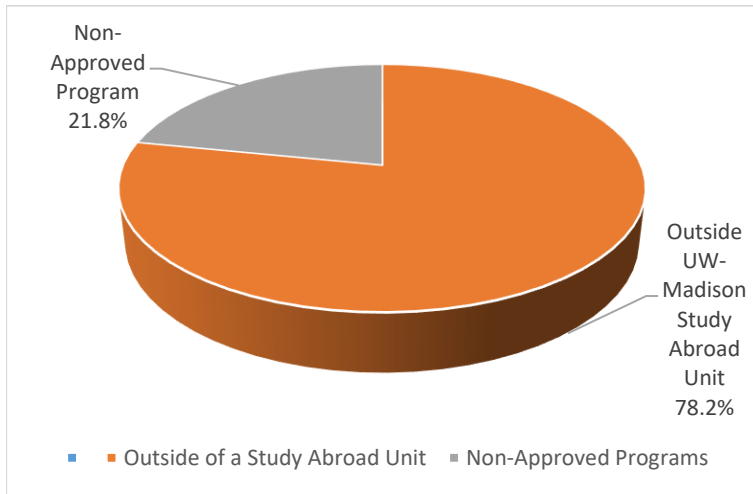

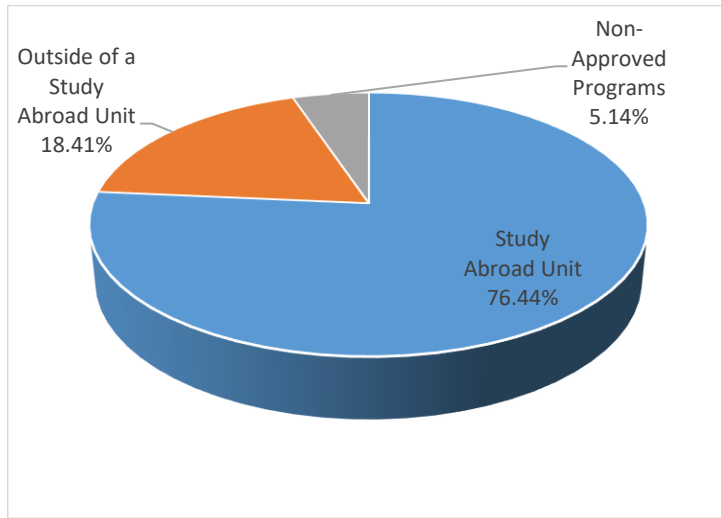
### III. Participation by UW-Madison Students who Studied through a Non-Study Abroad Administrative Unit

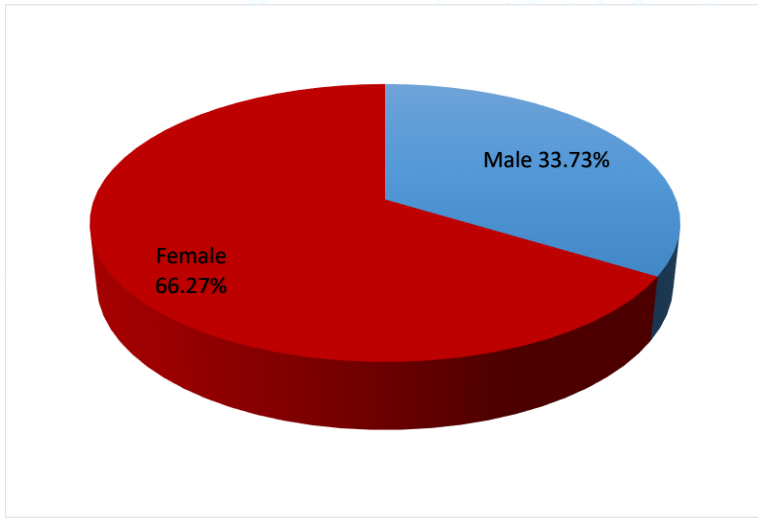

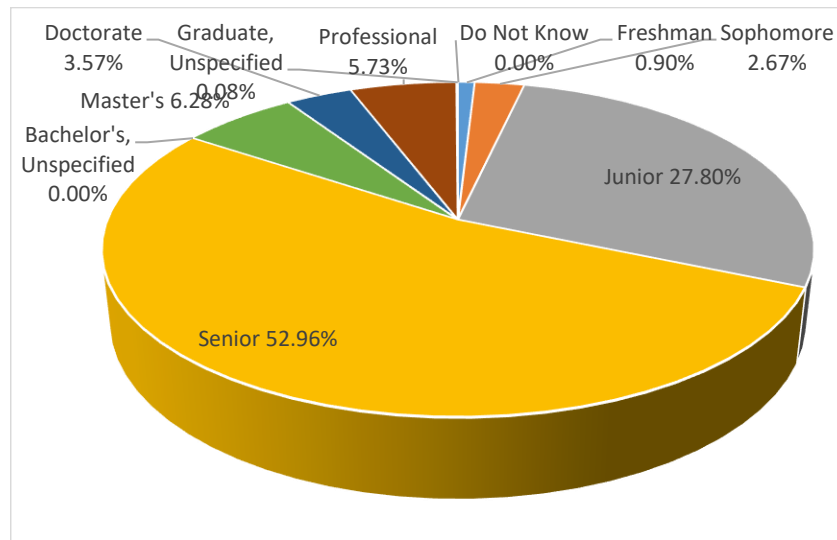

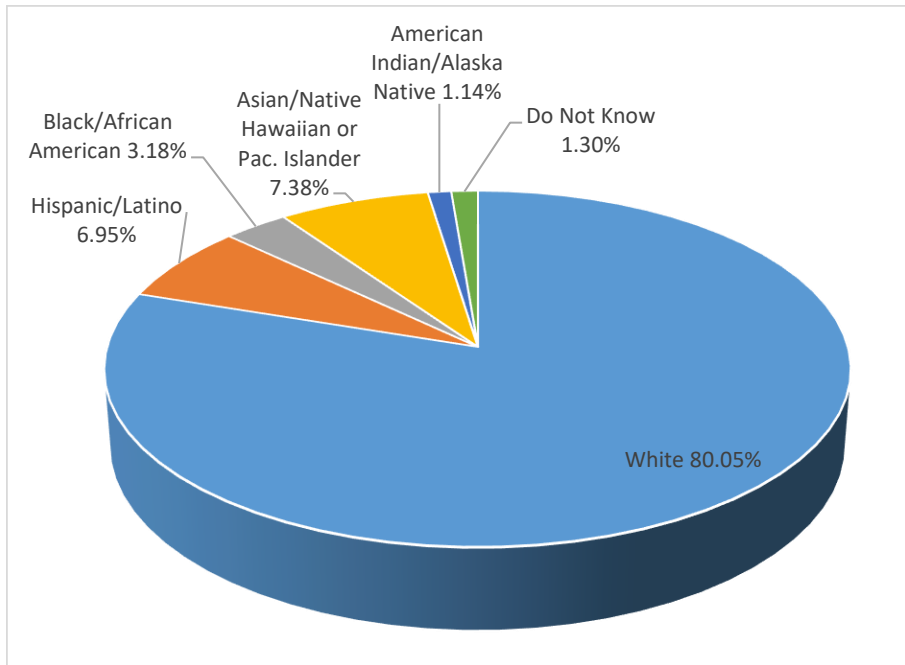

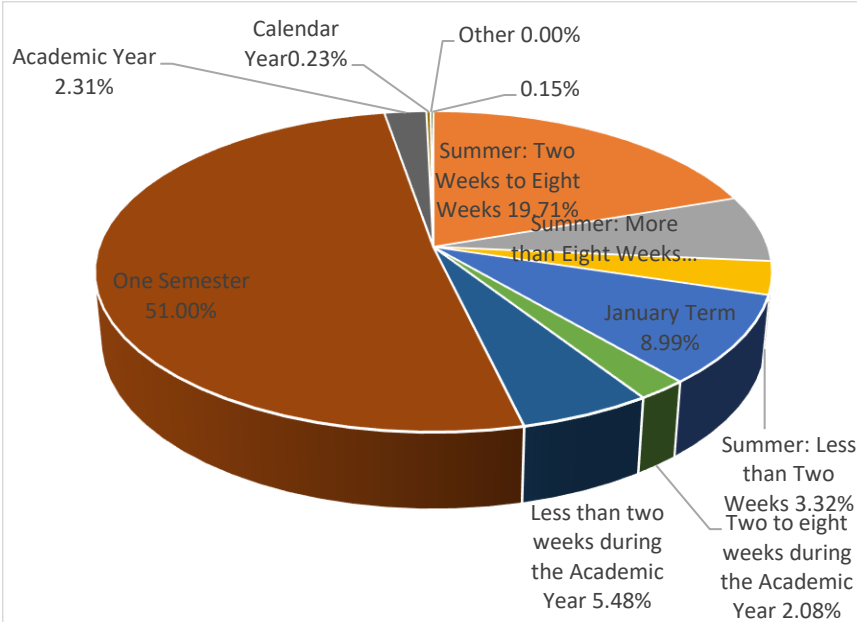

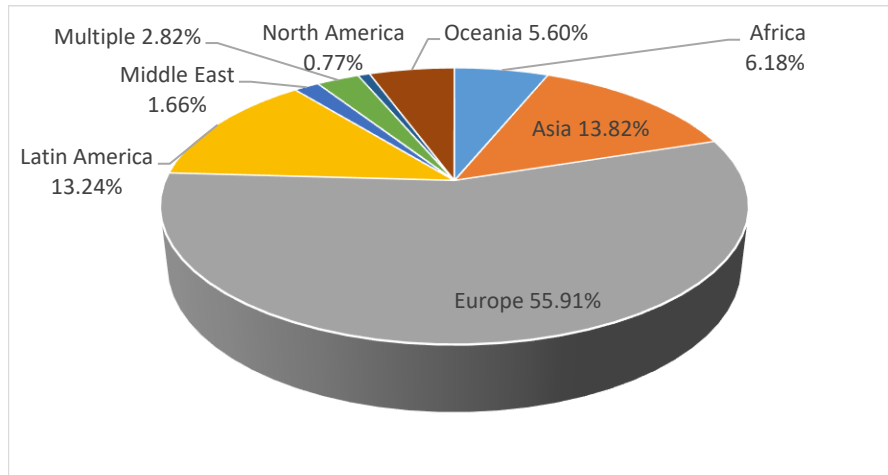
